

## Event Report on Skill Development Seminar on AI and Networking Skills

### Organizers:

### **Keynote Speech:**

The First session was conducted by the Resource person, Rtn Dr Aysha V, Principal of IHRD College of Applied Science, Mavelikkara, on *INTRODUCTION TO AI AND GEN AI TOOLS*. Mam introduced students to the foundational concepts of Artificial Intelligence, including its definition, key components, and how it is being integrated into various industries such as finance, marketing, education, and even in daily based activities. She extended her ideas through demonstrating real-world applications of AI, highlighting how technical tools and apps like ChatGPT, machine learning are helpful when it comes to acquiring new knowledge.
